### 2020-2021 Winter Athletics Fan Policy

Mountie Nation:

With the ongoing impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, we have to continue to alter the environments of our high school and middle school athletic events to comply with various state and local policies and guidelines. Please refer to the below policy when attending events held at Mapleton High School for the 2020-2021 winter season.

Tickets:

With the capacity limits in place, there are less tickets available to our basketball players, wrestlers, cheerleaders, and sweethearts. Considering roster sizes and participating teams, the following ticket limits will be in place:

Boys Basketball- Basketball players, cheerleaders, and sweethearts are limited to **two tickets per game.**

Girls Basketball- Basketball players are limited to **three tickets per game.**

Middle School Basketball- Boys and girls basketball players are limited to **three tickets per game.**

Wrestling- Ticket allotments will vary depending on the event and the number of teams present.

We will work to make special consideration for events such as senior night. Tickets are to be used by family members and loved ones only. Tickets will continue to be \$6 per game.

Passes:

As with the fall, **we are unable to honor lifetime passes, gold passes, and staff passes this year.** However, we are going to be offering sports-specific passes for high school boys and girls basketball. This will reduce the need to purchase pre-sale tickets for every single game. Pass information will be made available through our Mapleton AD Facebook page. The passes will only be accepted at the sporting events for which they are purchased.

Seating:

**Physically distanced seating will be enforced at every sporting event at Mapleton High School.** A minimum of six feet in every direction is required between spectators who do not reside at the same household. The bleachers will be marked to assist in finding physically distanced seating.

Masks/Face Coverings:

**A mask or face covering is required for every spectator in attendance.** The face covering must be worn for the entirety of the event. The only exemptions will be those listed in the governor's order regarding face coverings in public.

Game Day Expectations:

**All spectators are expected to complete a symptom check prior to their arrival at Mapleton High School.** This includes a temperature being taken to detect a fever. Any spectator experiencing or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 are asked and expected to refrain from attending any event at Mapleton High School.

**Immediately following an event, spectators will be asked to vacate the gym and high school** to allow our custodial staff to begin the process of cleaning and sanitizing the gym.

**There is a strict no-entry policy this year.** This includes those spectators who have left the facility to smoke.

In closing, our Mountie student-athletes are looking forward to having a winter sports season. The cooperation of our parents and fans will play into their ability to do so. Please respect the mandates that are put into place to increase the probability of athletic events to continue to take place.
